
**Minutes of the IQAC meeting held on September 23<sup>rd</sup> 2015 in the IQAC office of the College.**

**Minutes of the IQAC meeting held on January 5<sup>th</sup> 2016 in the IQAC office of the College.**


The Principal and Chairperson: Mr. Krishne Gowda extended a warm welcome to all the members.

**Minutes of the IQAC meeting held on April 22<sup>nd</sup> ,2016 in the IQAC office of the College.**



## Action Taken Report (ATR) based on the plan of action decided upon at the beginning of the academic year

■ Almost all the items in the plan of action at the beginning of the year could successfully be executed namely., Post Graduate courses viz., MSc in Physics and Computer Science and under-graduate course with combination Criminology and food and nutrition became functional.
