## The Action Taken Report (ATR) based on the plan of action decided upon at the beginning of the year

Almost all the items in the plan of action at the beginning of the year could successfully be executed namely.,

Orientation Programme was conducted to all the teaching faculty on recent advancements pertaining to teaching methods & other pedagogical skills.

Orientation Programme was conducted in the beginning of the academic year for the complete personality development in the following areas for:
