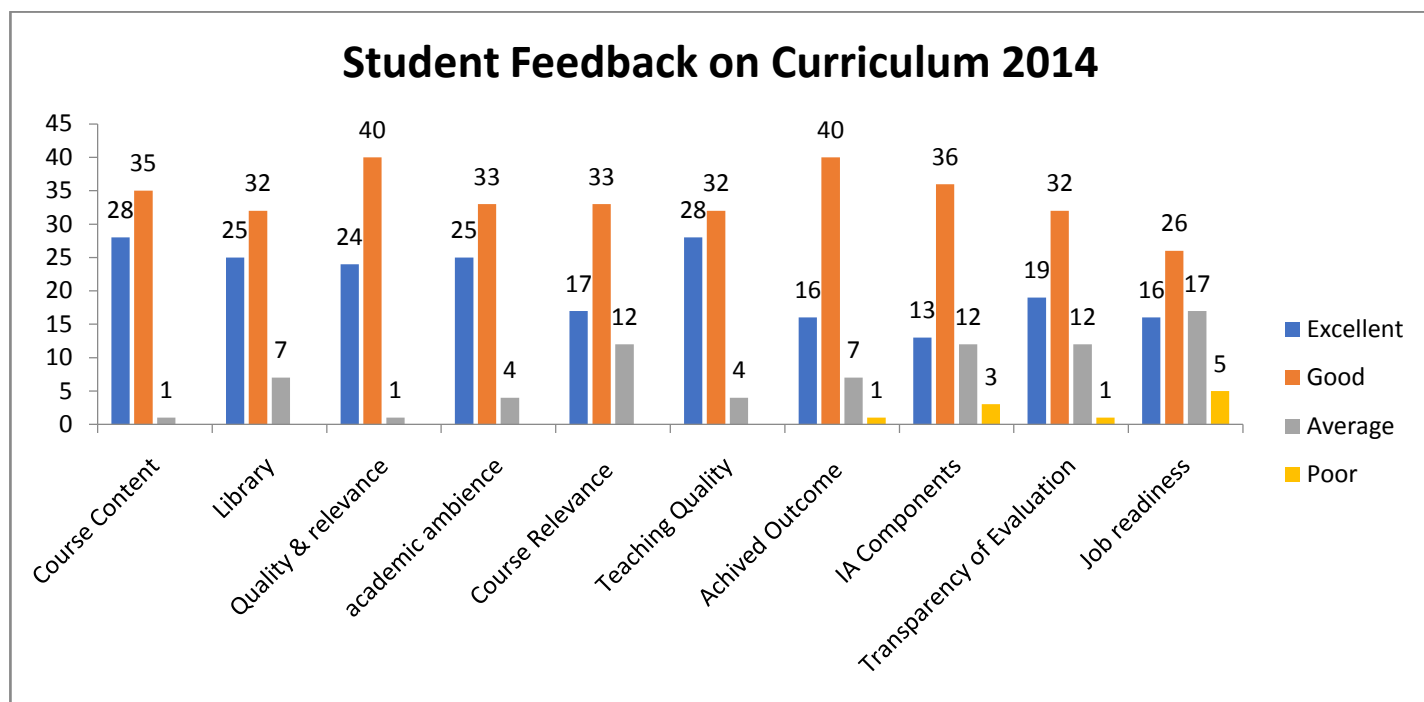


Student Feedback on Curriculum 2014



The Graph explains feedback by the students' on curriculum adopted for learning during an academic year 2012-14. Most of the opinion from students' respondents ranged as good. A total 65 students' were interviewed to know their perception on curriculum depicts that in all dimensions for curriculum the students fraternity referred the as good. More than half i.e., 55% students said course content and IA components as good, where as 51% students' mentioned library services, teaching quality and transparency of evaluation as good. As much as 62% respondents' opined quality and relevance of curriculum and achieved outcome as good, followed by 52% students respondents' made a mention that academic ambience and course relevance as good. Less than half of 42% students were of the opinion that curriculum was helpful in job readiness.

Action taken: The feedback was analyzed and based on the input, new innovative courses were introduced. CBCS system was introduced for BCA, BSW, BTHM and B.Com programs'. It was decided in the Academic Council meeting to introduce Alternate English as a language for Foreign students. The curriculum was restructured and incorporated in the next academic year.
