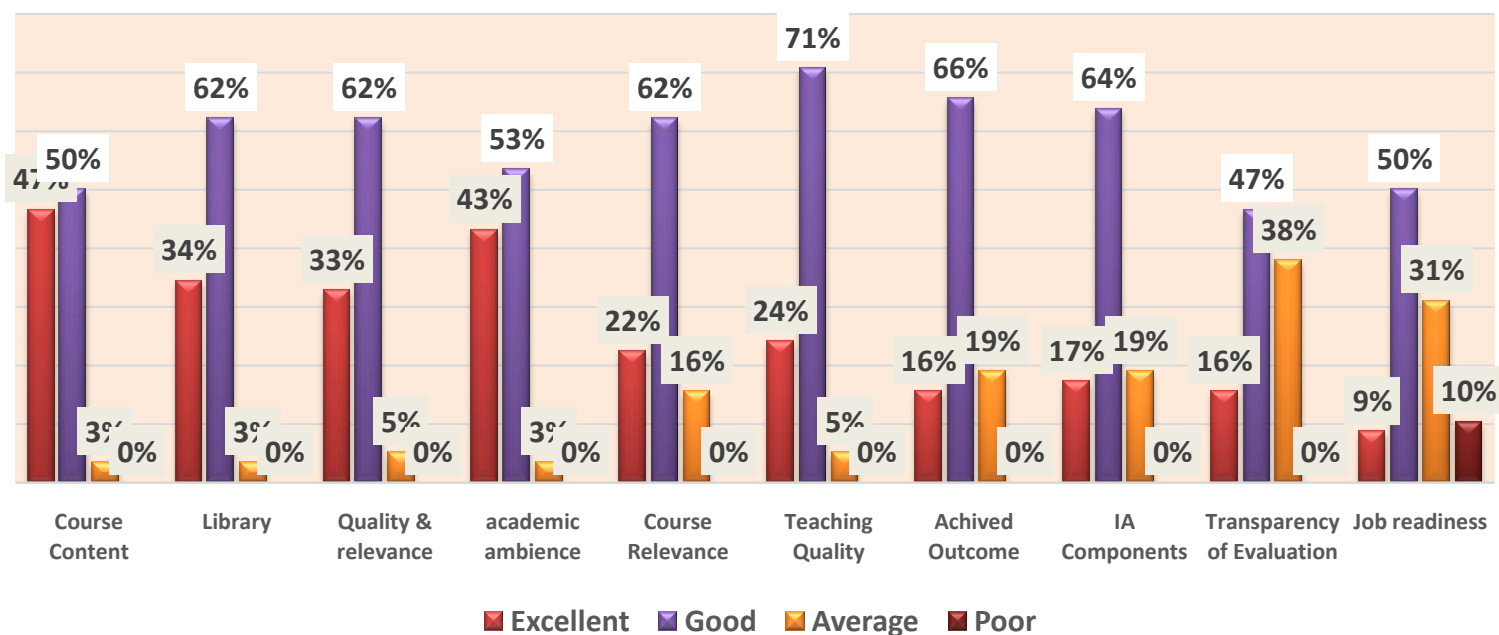


Student Feedback on Curriculum 2016

Students Feedback on Curriculum 2016



The following graph examines on the opinion received by the students on curriculum for 2014-16 batch. A total of 58 students were interviewed. A majority of the students opined and rated the curriculum as good. It seems that 71% student respondents said teaching quality as good, followed by 66% & 64% respondents mentioned curriculum helpful in achieving outcome and IA components as good respectively. More than half of 62% students respondents' said that library services, quality and relevance of curriculum & course relevance as good, where in 53% opined academic ambience as good, where as 50% students respondents said course content & job readiness as good. Less than half i.e., 47% said the transparency of evaluation adopted as good.

Action taken:

Based on the input received, it was decided to introduce more new courses with better scope for higher education and research. Project presentation was added. More new Post graduate programmes' were introduced. When restructuring the syllabi, care was taken to eliminate overlapping course contents in related programs. Industrialists and entrepreneurs were involved while framing the curriculum. Topics which make stake holders industry ready and which enhance self employment were incorporated in the curriculum.
