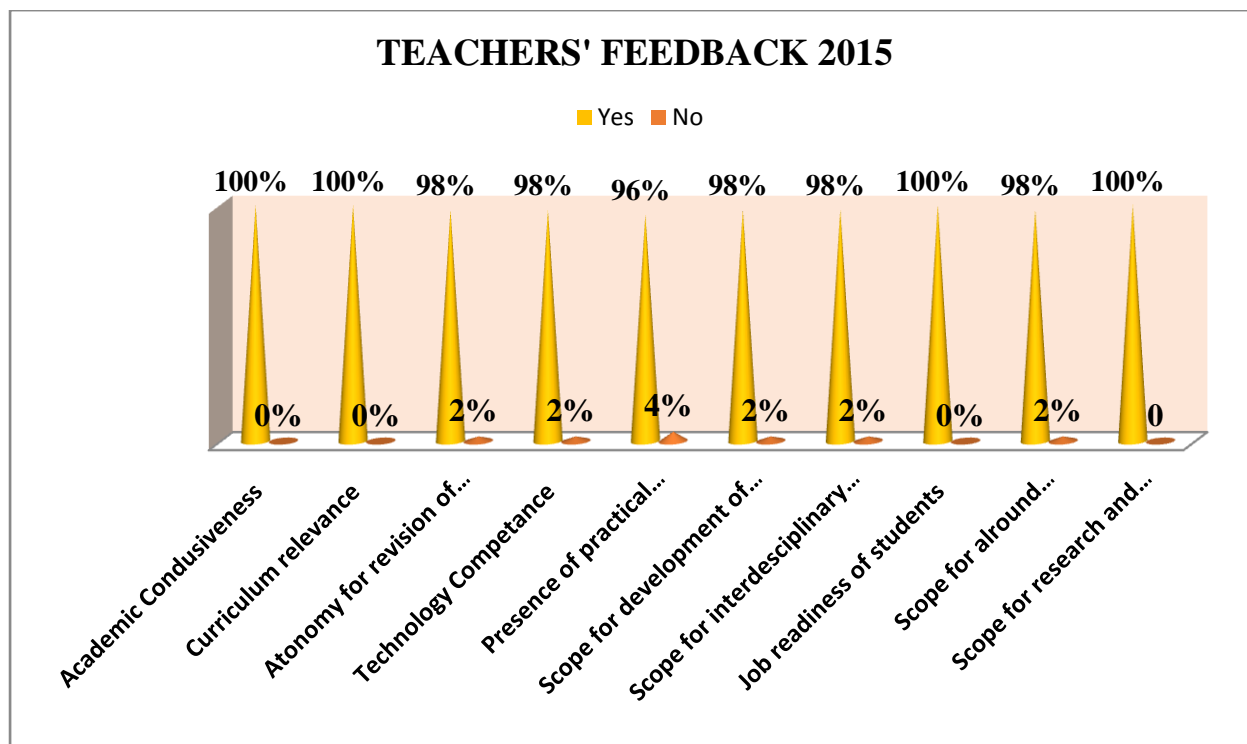


Teachers' Feedback 2015



The table 3 examines on Teachers' Feedback during 2015-16 on impact of academic curriculum on students' overall learning and development. A total of 48 teachers were interviewed to know their opinion on academic curriculum. Almost all teachers have shown affirmative opinion. All teachers i.e., 100% (48) have said that it is academically conducive, no doubt it has curriculum relevance, enhances skills for job readiness among students and it has got wide scope for research and development. As much as 98% teachers' opined that there is a great autonomy for revision of syllabus, technology competence, there is a huge scope for faculty development further it enhances scope for interdisciplinary curriculum which further leads to scope for all round development; Whereas 96% teachers' observed that it has presence of practical component. The data shows that the teachers' are strongly agreed that the curriculum is good.

Action Taken:

2. Suggestions were considered and the syllabi were modified based on need.
3. New practical components were introduced to enrich the curriculum.
4. Faculty enrichment programs were conducted.
