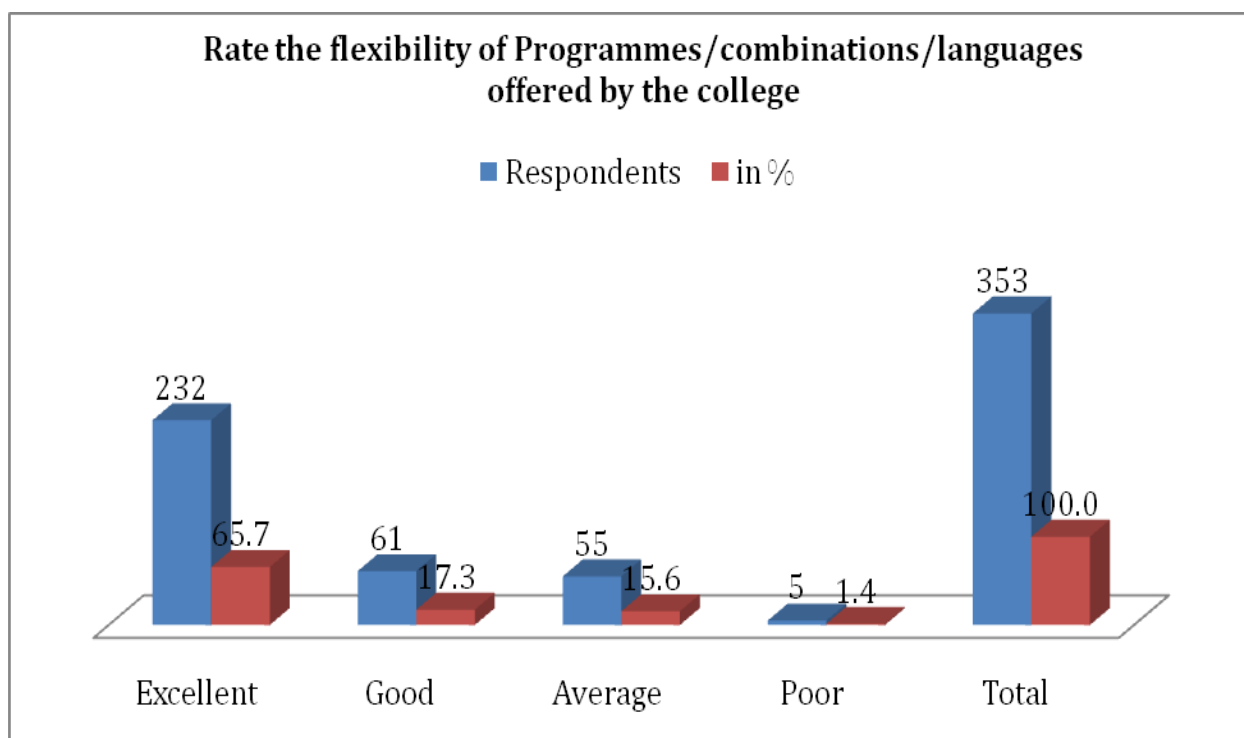
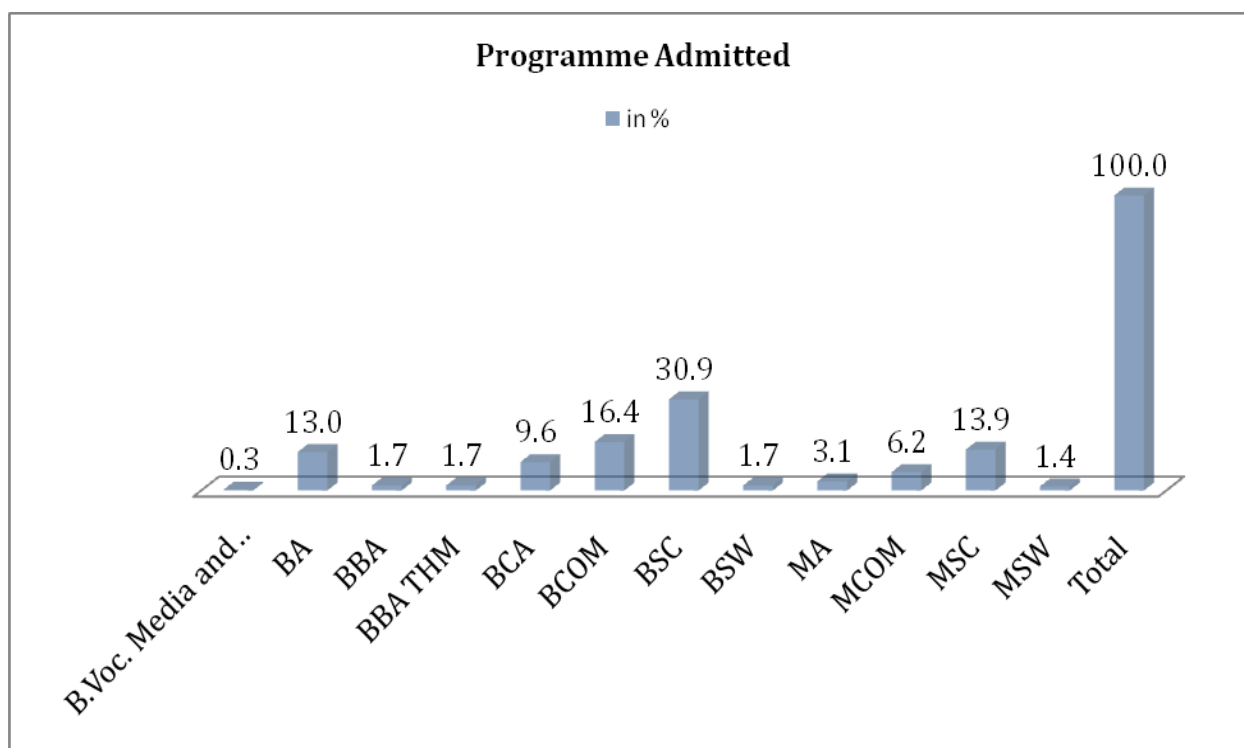
The following is the analysis of number of responses per question. Based on mean value of each questions, action and recommendations were made.

Mean score:

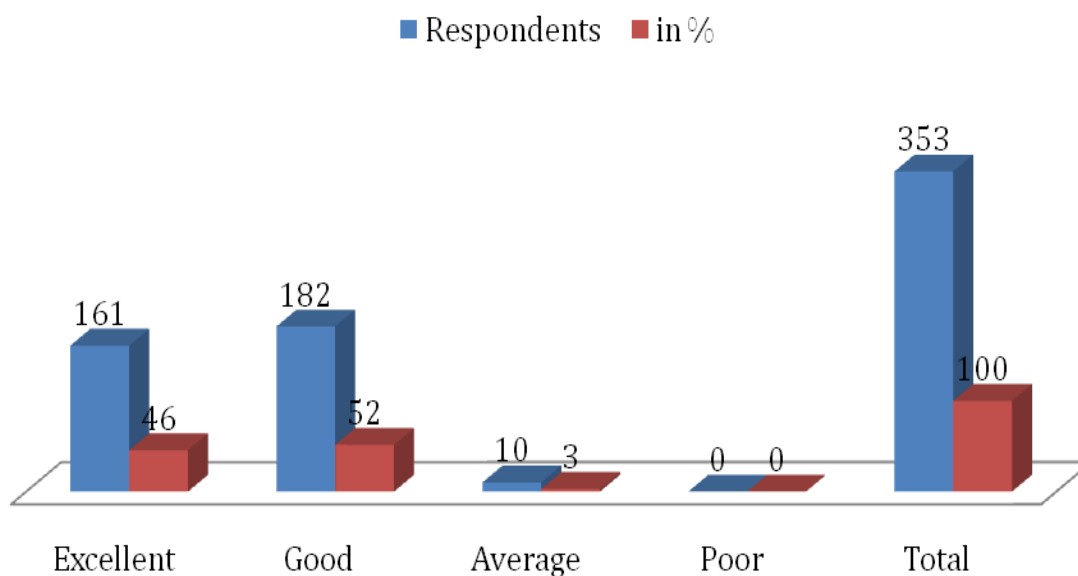

In order to achieve this, responses for each question was collected in a scale of 1-4, with 4 being the Excellent and 1 being Poor. The average score was calculated over total responses collected over time for all the programs and it was analyzed by using the SPSS software.

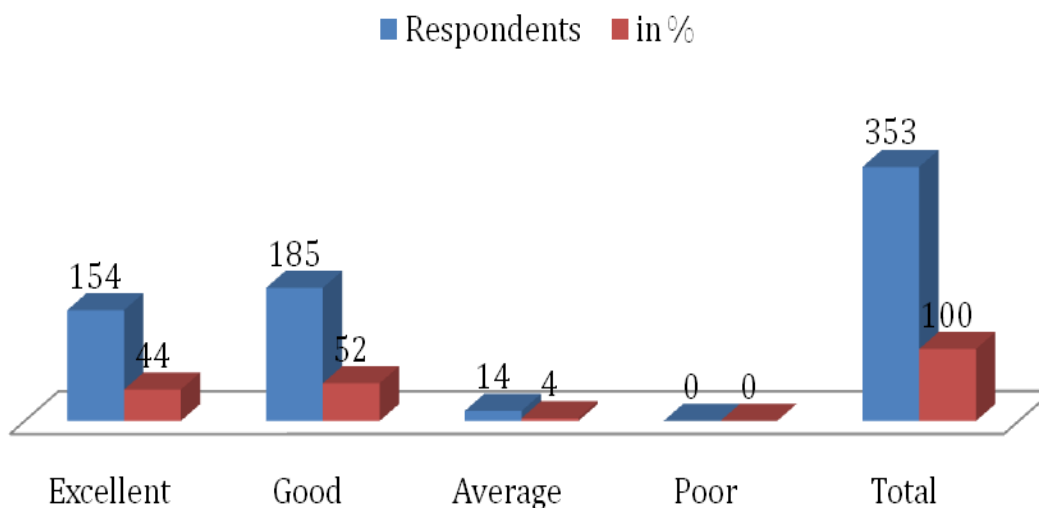

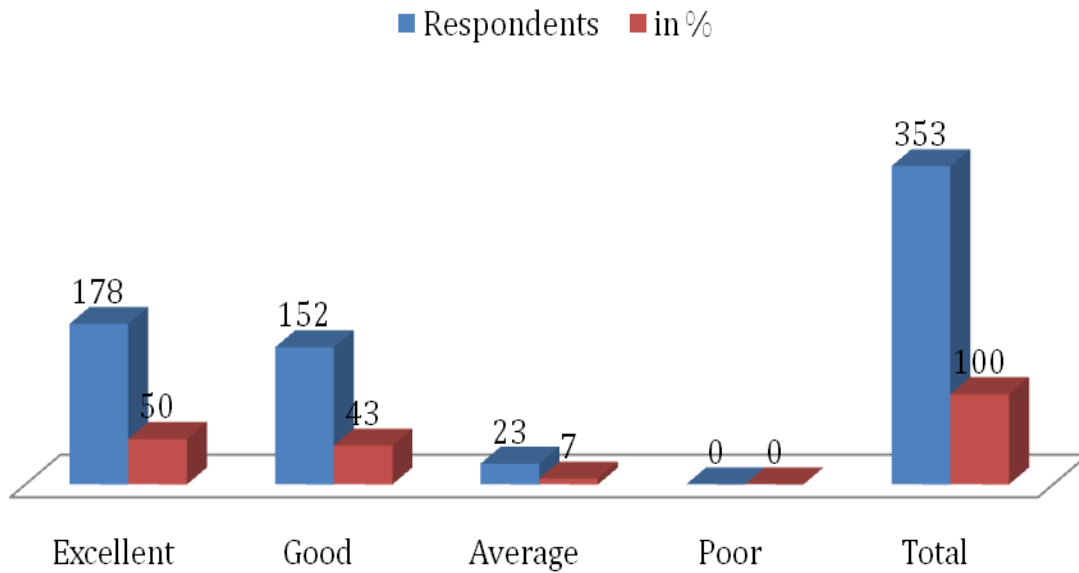

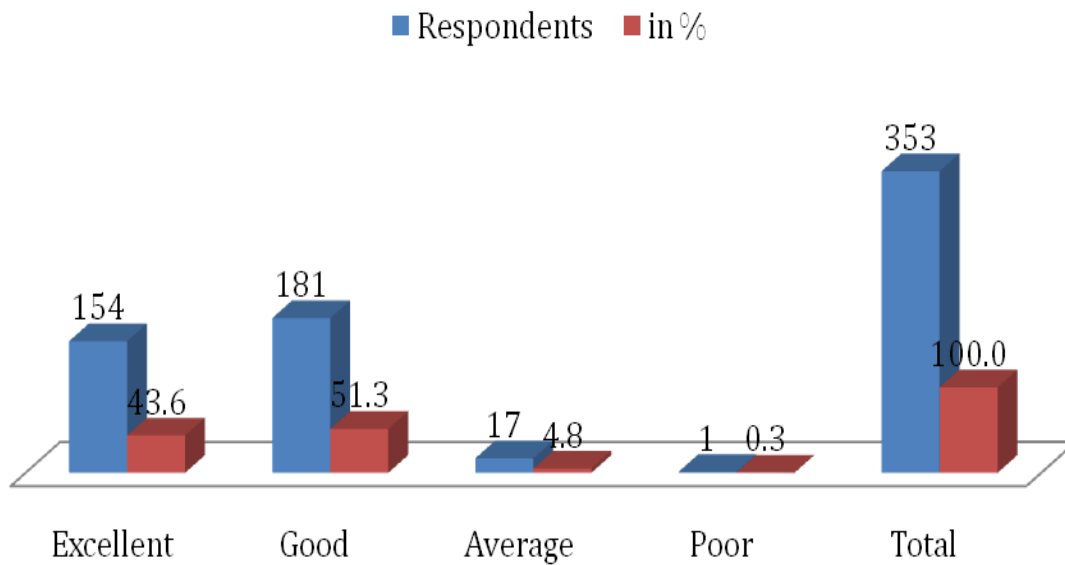
Rate the treatment of the students by the faculty irrespective of their background (Gender, cast, community, creed etc.) in teaching and evaluation



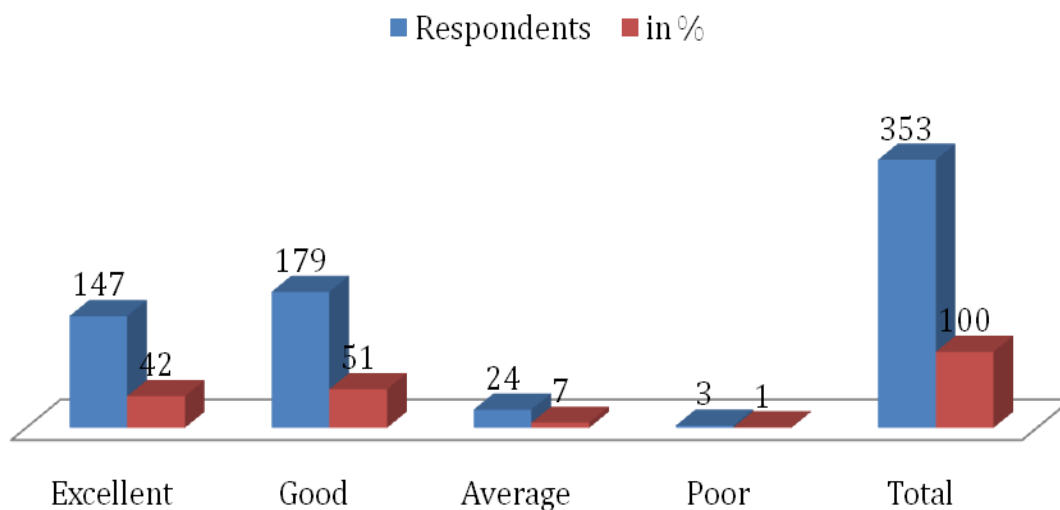
Rate the academic ambience of the college for effective learning



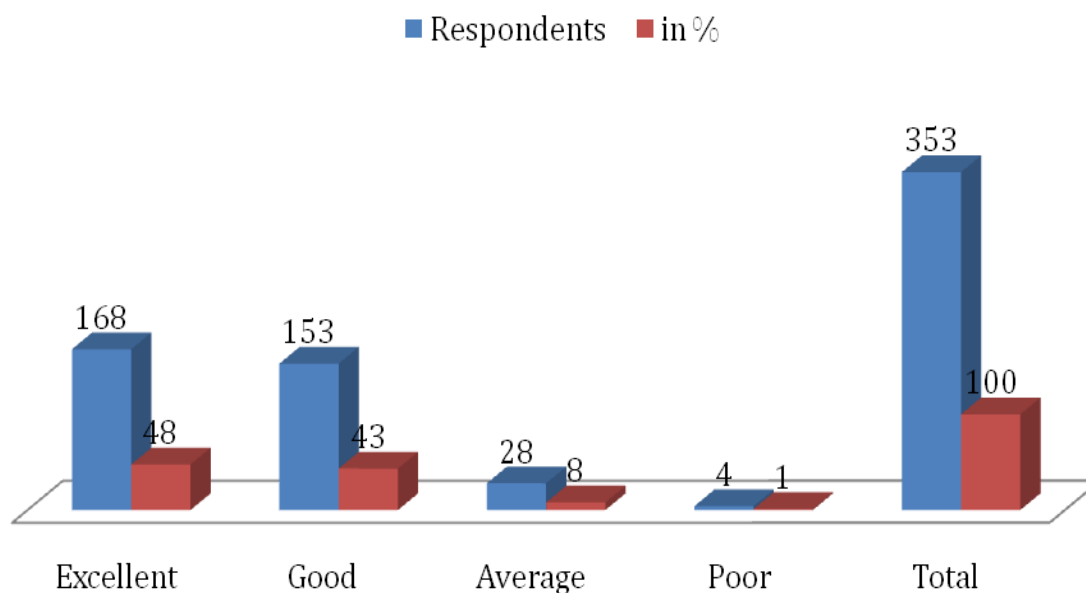
Rate the courses in terms of their relevance to the latest and/or future technologies



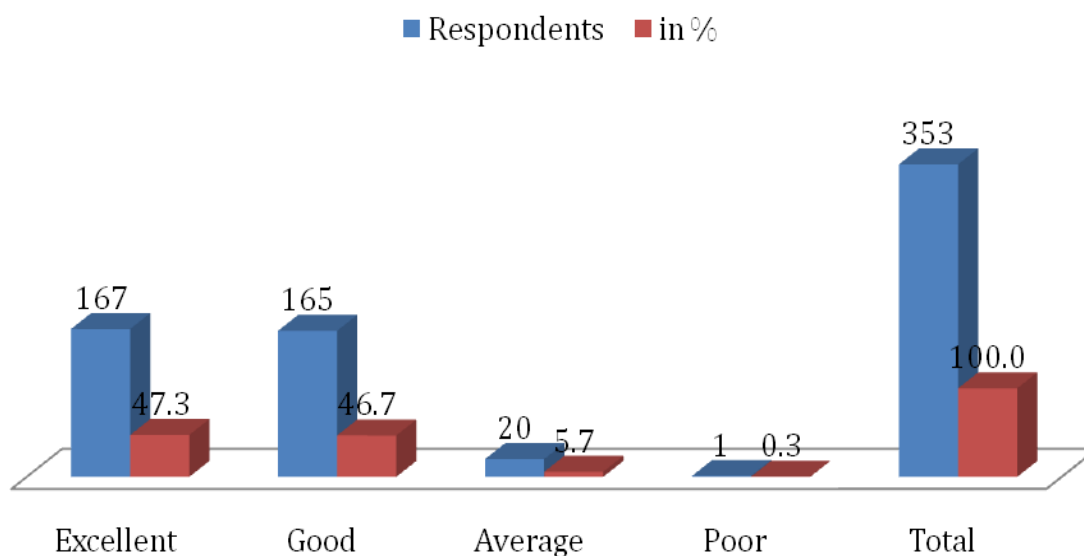
Rate the programmes/courses in terms of skills and hand-on experience



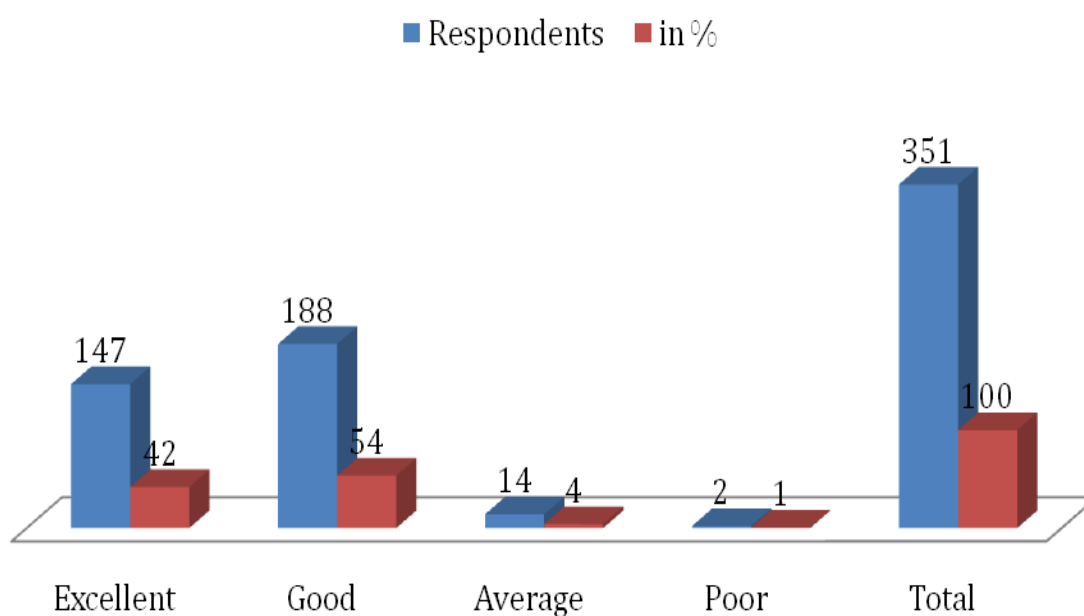
Rate the quality of the teaching in the Institution

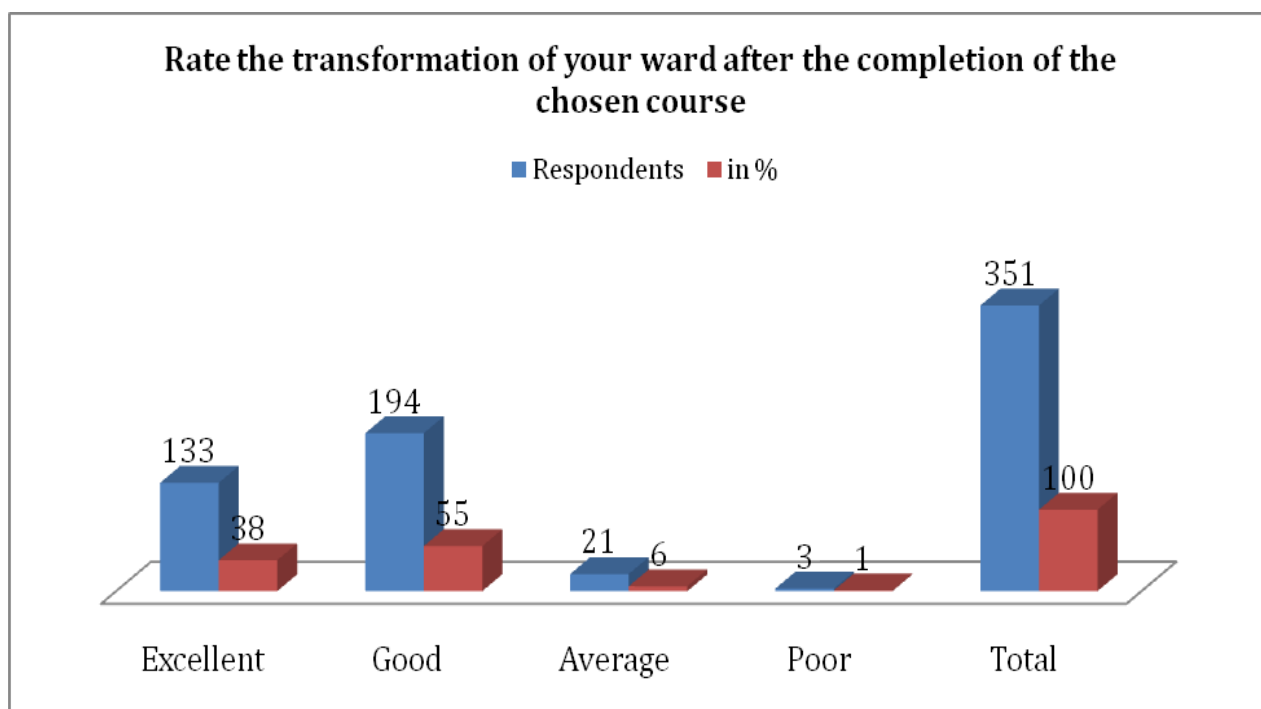


Rate the outcomes that your ward has achieved from the courses
