2. उसमें किसी प्रकार का कॉपीराइट उल्लंघन नहीं होना चाहिए।
3. शोधालेख स्वरचित एवं मौलिक होना चाहिए।
4. शोधालेख की प्लैगिजिज्म रिपोर्ट भी साथ संलग्न करें, ताकि उसमें चोरी की सामग्री ना होने का प्रमाण मिल सके।
5. शोधालेख में कोई विवादास्पद, राष्ट्रविरोधी एवं किसी की भावनाओं को ठेस पहुँचाने वाली सामग्री नहीं होनी चाहिए।
6. शोधालेख में भारत सरकार द्वारा स्वीकृत मानक वर्तनी का प्रयोग किया जाए।
7. शोधालेख भेजने से पहले वर्तनी की शुद्धता को अत्यंत ध्यान से जाँच लें। भाषा व्याकरण सम्मत एवं संस्कृतनिष्ठ होनी चाहिए। अनावश्यक अंग्रेजी/उर्दू शब्दों का प्रयोग वाँछनीय नहीं है।
