#### **BRIEF HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE**

The vision of the Catholic Bishop of Mysore and the munificence of the Maharaja of Mysore culminated in the establishment of St. Philomena's College in the year 1946 on a plot of 29 acres of land in the Garden city of Mysore. It was the first private Science Degree College to be affiliated with the University of Mysore.

The College was declared open by His Highness Sri. Jayachamaraja Wodeyar, the then Maharaja of Mysore, a rare honour and a privilege for any institution. The College is a Christian Minority Institution governed by the Mysore Diocesan Educational Society (Regd.) (MDES) under the Chairmanship of His Excellency, the Bishop of Mysore.

The College was conferred Autonomous status in the year 2011 by the UGC.


- ♦ The UGC recognized the College with the status of "College with Potential for Excellence" (CPE) in the year 2010.

## CURRICULUM (NEP 2020)

The College at the undergraduate level has introduced NEP 2020 multidisciplinary programmes from the academic year 2021 - 2022. The NEP curriculum is focused on creativity and innovation, critical thinking, problem-solving, teamwork, communication skills, and other skills.

**THE CURRICULUM:** The PG programme courses are designed to meet the requirement of the Learning Outcome Curriculum Framework (LOCF) with the Vision and Mission of the College. The curriculum has definite Programme Educational Objectives, Programme Outcomes, and Programme Specific Outcomes. The curriculum offers Discipline Specific Courses, Discipline Specific Electives, Interdisciplinary, Ability Enhancement, Skill Enhancement, Generic, Self-Study, Value Added courses with Project Work, Internship, Fieldwork, and UGC - MOOC Online Courses. Each course has definite Course Objectives, Course Learning Outcomes, and Keywords at the end of each module to map the course learning outcomes with programme specific outcomes and cognitive domain levels of Bloom's Taxonomy.

**TEACHING AND LEARNING:** Effective teaching strategies are adopted to develop competency in communication skills, critical thinking, effective skills, problem-solving, analytical, reasoning, research skills, teamwork, digital literacy, moral and ethical awareness, and leadership readiness with other learner-centric modes which individual courses may demand.

Some important and relevant teaching and learning processes adopted are flipped, hybrid /blended, and sessions like seminars, group discussions, workshops, laboratory-based practical, extension activities to learn the moral & ethical awareness, self-paced learning, National/ International Seminars, Guest lectures, research activities leading to the publication of research articles in peer-reviewed Journals. In addition, the faculty members help slow learners by offering bridge courses and remedial classes.

**RESEARCH:** The PG research center has a well-equipped research laboratory. The faculty members and students are actively involved in research and regularly publishing research articles in peer-reviewed journals. The faculty also support the students to get grants from various state and central governments. The College management is continuously encouraging the research culture among faculty and students by providing generous seed money.

**ATTENDANCE:** 75% Attendance is compulsory and the students who do not have 75% of attendance in all the courses are not eligible to write the summative examination.

**EXAMINATIONS / RESULTS / AWARD OF DEGREE:** The College will strictly adhere to the University of Mysore Notifications/ regulations regarding the examinations, results, and award of degree.

**AMENITIES:** The College has excellent infrastructure with the entire campus being networked with OFC and Wi-Fi hotspots, well-equipped Laboratories, a state-of-the-art central library with rich print and e-resources, ICT-enabled classrooms, auditorium, language lab, e-studio, conference halls, spacious playgrounds, and an Indoor stadium.

**CRECHE:** The College has established a Day Care Center for children of the staff and the students. The experienced staff look after the children with care, dedication, and commitment.

**CAFETERIA:** The College campus has 3 Cafeterias at strategic locations wherein a wide range of hygienic food items are available.

**BANKING FACILITY:** The Nationalized Canara Bank Branch is functioning on the College premises. There are two ATM outlets in the College Campus, one from the Canara Bank and the other from the South Indian Bank providing 24 x 7, banking facilities all through the year.

#### **PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION**

The filled-in application duly signed by the student and the parent/guardian should be submitted to the College office for registration with the prescribed registration fee. Unregistered applications will not be considered. Preserve your registration number till the admission process is successfully completed.

#### **ADMISSION GUIDELINES**

- 1. The application form should be attached with Photo Copies (not the originals) of Pre-University / XII Std Marks Card, Conduct Certificate, Transfer Certificate, 4 passport size photos, and Aadhaar Card.
  - Note: Students seeking admissions to PG courses should follow the regulations laid by the University of Mysore. For information, contact the PG Admission Office @ 08214240 306/997 / 918 / 900 or Mobile: 9008580707, 6364118983
- 2. The Foreign students should enclose in addition to the above, the photocopies of all the pages of the passport where legal entries are made.
- 3. The application will be processed within 10 days and the selected students will be intimated either over the phone or through email.
- 4. The selected students should come along with their parents/guardians within the specified date & time with the original SSLC, PUC / 12th Class marks card, Transfer Certificate, and two stamp sized photographs. The students will forfeit their seats if they do not take up the admission within the allotted time.
- 5. The SC / ST students should bring the original caste certificate and two attested copies of the same. The SC/ST students should apply for scholarships to the respective Government Departments from which their fee amount will be reimbursed. As per the latest Government of Karnataka notification, all the fee concessions will be credited by the Government directly to the students' bank accounts. Eligible students should submit relevant documents along with Aadhaar card and bank account number while applying.
- 6. The students residing outside Mysore City seeking admission need to submit a written undertaking from a local guardian (residing within Mysore City) so that they may be contacted in case of any emergency.
- 7. The students admitted will be issued an Identity Card and the students should wear their ID cards before entering the college premises.
- 8. As directed by the Government of Karnataka and the University of Mysore, all the details of the students should be entered by the students themselves into the universal portal (UUCMS) Unified University & College Management System website <a href="https://uucms.karnataka.gov.in/Login/Index">https://uucms.karnataka.gov.in/Login/Index</a>

# **Eligibility Certificate:**

- For Students outside Karnataka: The students who have studied outside Karnataka State are considered Outside Karnataka students. These students need to submit an eligibility certificate from the University of Mysore. The students can apply for an eligibility certificate directly to the university. The application is available on the university website- https://uni-mysore.ac.in. The college also makes arrangements to get the eligibility certificate from the university for those students who get admitted to the College.
- Foreign Nationals: The students who have a Passport issued by the Government of India or by a Foreign Nation and who have studied outside India are considered Foreign Nationals. These students should obtain the eligibility certificate directly from the University of Mysore before admission. The application is available on the university website- <a href="https://uni-mysore.ac.in">https://uni-mysore.ac.in</a>

The Foreign Nationals other than NRI should submit the original documents of their Passport, Visa, and Residential Agreement to the Commissioner of Police to get the Residential Permit.
