### Agenda :

1. To modify the curriculum by a minimum of 30% for the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Semester courses.
2. Overview of existing SEP Karnataka syllabus for the 1<sup>st</sup> semester (to be retained).

The meeting was initiated by Ms. MARY IRENE, Chairperson, BOS, who emphasized the need to update the curriculum for the V and VI semesters.

It was acknowledged that a minimum 30% modification is required to address gaps in the current syllabus, reflect new trends, and meet industry demands. Ms. MARY IRENE [Chairperson] also reiterated that the SEP Karnataka University Syllabus for the 1<sup>st</sup> semester would be retained as it is current and comprehensive.

## 1. Proposed Modifications to the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> semester Syllabus:-

Discussions focused on specific areas where the 30% curriculum change would be implemented.

Key suggestions include:

- Integration of Nanotechnology in <sup>Food Preservation</sup> (Unit 4).
- The chapter name of Unit 3 was changed from "Modern Food Preservation" to "Food Processing".
- The concepts were rearranged to ensure they fit appropriately within their respective chapters, aligning content with the correct thematic focus.
- In paper VII, the suggestion to prioritize the addition of Nutrition care process has been made.
- In paper VII (Food Microbiology), the emphasis was including detailed information about Food borne pathogen and food safety & Quality.
- Alterations were suggested in the section <sup>important</sup> on Neurological disorders and its dietary management in paper 8.

## 2. Retention of the 1<sup>st</sup> Semester Syllabus.

- It was unanimously agreed to retain the 1<sup>st</sup> semester syllabus as provided by SEP Karnataka.
- This syllabus is in alignment with the current educational standards.






