# Proceedings of the BOS meeting held on 14.03.2020 at 10.00 am in the conference hall under the chairmanship of Dr. Ravi J.D. Saldhanha, HOD of Chemistry.

1.At the outset, the chairman welcomed the members. Prof. Mohana K.N, University nominee could not attend the meeting as the UOM had declared holidays for corona virus issue.

2. Three members who were included in the newly formed B.O.S team for the term 2019-22 as external members were introduced to the house by the chairman.
They are:

1. Dr. K.R Anil Kumar, Head, Food Quality & Assurance Dept, DFRL, Mysore

Dr. P.G Chandrashekara, HOD, DOS in Chemistry, Yuvaraja's College, Mysore

3. Dr. Shivaprasad C.M, HOD, Dept of Chemistry, GFGC, Vijayanagar, Mysore

 Mrs. Bindu Noronha read out the minutes of the previous meeting which was held on 6<sup>th</sup> June 2018. The Board considered and confirmed the minutes.

4. After the agenda items water taken up the Board discussed and recommended as under:

- For academic session 2020-21, for 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> semesters, minor changes can be incorporated
  in the syllabus but not to 1 to 4 semesters. Changes if any, to 1 to 4<sup>th</sup> can be made in the
  next meeting as it would complete one full term of CBCS syllabus introduced in 2018.
- Dr. K.R. Anil Kumar suggested to introduce industrial visits/projects/internship etc in the final year B.Sc.
- iii. Prof. Dephan Pinheiro, shared his views regarding internship/projects to the students. He said that, in Christ University where he is working, a creamy layer of students are selected from the final year B.Sc and are asked to do projects/internships. The outcome result for the past few years has been excellent, he said. If adequate infrastructure facilities are available and if teaching faculty can take up this issue it could be considered here too, he said.

The board expressed its satisfaction on this issue and gave its approval to initiate action.

- iv. When suggestions were invited from Dr. P.G. Chandrashekara, he said that in the recently held BOS at Yuvaraja College and PG studies & Research in Chemistry, Manasagangotri, Mysore, the project work and internship have been removed from the syllabus owing to non-availability of institutions/organizations ready to receive students and also due to the duplication of work by the students.
- v. Dr. Shivaprasad C.M was also of the same opinion, but said that it can be incorporated here as the institution requires skill based curriculum in order to be evaluated for accreditation. Also, the institution does not face dearth of funds.
- Later, the board took up entire CBCS syllabus (2018 onwards) for discussion and approved the same by suggesting a few minor changes.

Prof. P.G.Chandrashekara, Member(External) and Dr.Alphonsus D'Souza, Member.(Internal) could not attend the meeting due to their prior commitment and were granted leave of absence

The Chairman, BOS welcomed and introduced the members of BOS who were present for the meeting and thanked each one of them for sparing their valuable time to attend the meeting.

The meeting was thereafter deliberated on agenda items.

Item No. 1: To approve the minutes of last meeting of the BOS held on March 14, 2020.

The Chaiperson presented the minutes of the previous meeting which highlighted an overview of the course structure of CBCS for three-year B.Sc. degree course (2018 onwards)

The minutes of the last BOS meeting were approved by the BOS members.

# Item No. 2: To consider the review, assessment and approval of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester's syllabus of B.Sc Chemistry under NEP – 2020

The Chairperson presented the NEP syllabus and informed the members of BOS that the college Management has asked all UG departments to follow and implement the same syllabus which is prescribed by the UOM in Toto for the current academic year (both for 1 and 2 semesters). However, if any errors found in the syllabus, they can be discussed and those corrections can be incorporated.

The members had a fruitful discussion over the syllabus and interacted among themselves. The board made the following suggestions.

- In the first semester, prior to the start of practical classes, it is recommended to give a training session to the students regarding the precautions and safety measures to be followed.
- Course outcome should be framed in accordance with the Blooms taxonomy which is not followed in the UOM syllabus under course outcome.
- 3. It is recommended to include at least 02 more open elective papers in addition to the one which is already prescribed by the UOM. The reason being, the newly added elective papers can be offered to those students who are from non-science stream and the topics contain simple and basic concepts of Chemistry. Moreover, efforts

must be put while drafting the syllabus to create more interest in the subject among the students.

It was then resolved to authorize the Chairman, BOS to frame the syllabus of these new elective papers and place them in the AC meeting for concurrence. It was further resolved that the members of BOS also should be informed about the inclusion of OE papers and the copies must be e-mailed to them for reference.

 A few typographical/human errors found in the course content may be corrected.

For instance, in the First semester DSC paper, in unit III (Physical chemistry) under the chapter 'Gaseous State', topics such as 'coefficient of viscosity, variation of viscosity with temperature and pressure' are included. As a matter of fact, these topics are connected with Liquid state rather than the Gaseous State. Hence these topics should be included under the second chapter 'Liquid state'.

Also, under the Open Elective paper of Semester-1, in unit-II, a few typo errors viz. Vitamin-B1 instead of Vitamin-B1 and Vitamin-K1 instead of Vitamin-K1 are found. It is suggested to correct these errors and incorporate them in the syllabus.

5. Under the scheme of examination for DSC1 and 2, it is suggested to follow only 3+3 and 4+2 pattern in the question paper (for six marks questions) and not 2+2+2. This is because in Part-A of the question paper, students are required to answer a total of six 02 mark questions out of 08.

The Board, unanimously resolved to approve the NEP syllabus for the current academic year. The Board also authorized the Chairperson to do necessary changes in the syllabus if the UOM comes out with a further modified syllabus. For this, there is no need to call for one more BOS, instead the Chairperson can take a decision to adopt these changes but with a request to communicate to the members about the changes made, if any.

Dr.K.R.Anil Kumar, informed the Board that on account of Amrithamahotsava, which is being celebrated by the central Government institutes this year, there is a special provision given for the B.Sc students to visit DFRL and CFTRI institutes. In this connection, a request letter seeking permission of visit needs to be sent. The Chairperson immediately accepted this and agreed to write to the concerned Directors of these institutes for permission

The Chairperson thanked all the members for their kind cooperation and the meeting came to an end.
