do much discussion on this issue.





Offering Open Elective is mandatory,

keep the flow easy and smooth.


The meeting was concluded with




Later the discussion was upon the introduction of Allied English, a language paper which will offer as second language paper for the student whose 1st POC language is not offered in our college.
