


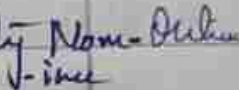


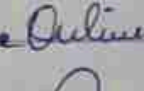

- ⑤ Three Skill based courses i.e. soft core of Mathematics for Chemists, Food and Pharmaceutical Analysis and Chemistry of Food and Beverages

- ⑥. One General Course i.e soft core of Chemistry in Day to Day Life in IV Semester.

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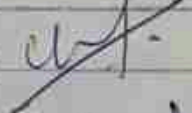


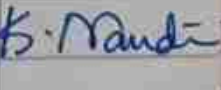
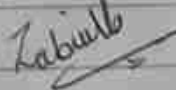

Agenda 1: Approval of the minutes of the previous meeting held on 08/04/22. The Chairperson placed the minutes before the members for discussion and approval.
Decision: Approved.

Agenda 2: To continue the existing Curriculum for the academic year 2023-25. Taking up the discussion, Chairperson Dr. Aksha informed the members that the current CBCS with a Learning Outcome Based (OBE) Curriculum was introduced in 2020-21. She further explained that with the introduction of the National Education Policy (NEP) by the Government of India and its subsequent adoption

by the Karnataka State Government, there is a possibility of introducing 4-year honours degree programmes and 2-year PG programmes. Consequently, the revision of the existing curriculum may be considered in the coming year to align with NEP curriculum pending clear guidelines from the state and the University.

The University Nominee recommended adopting the University PG Chemistry curriculum, as is being implemented in other autonomous colleges affiliated with the University of Mysore.

Decision: To adopt 70-80% of the University PG Chemistry curriculum for DSE courses and to incorporate the department's DSE course curriculum.

The meeting concluded with the Chairperson expressing gratitude to the members for their participation and valuable suggestions.



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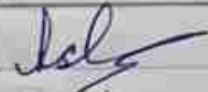
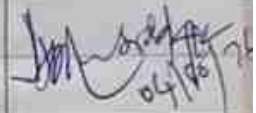
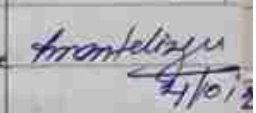


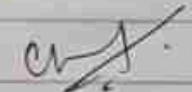




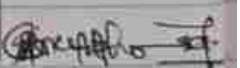
