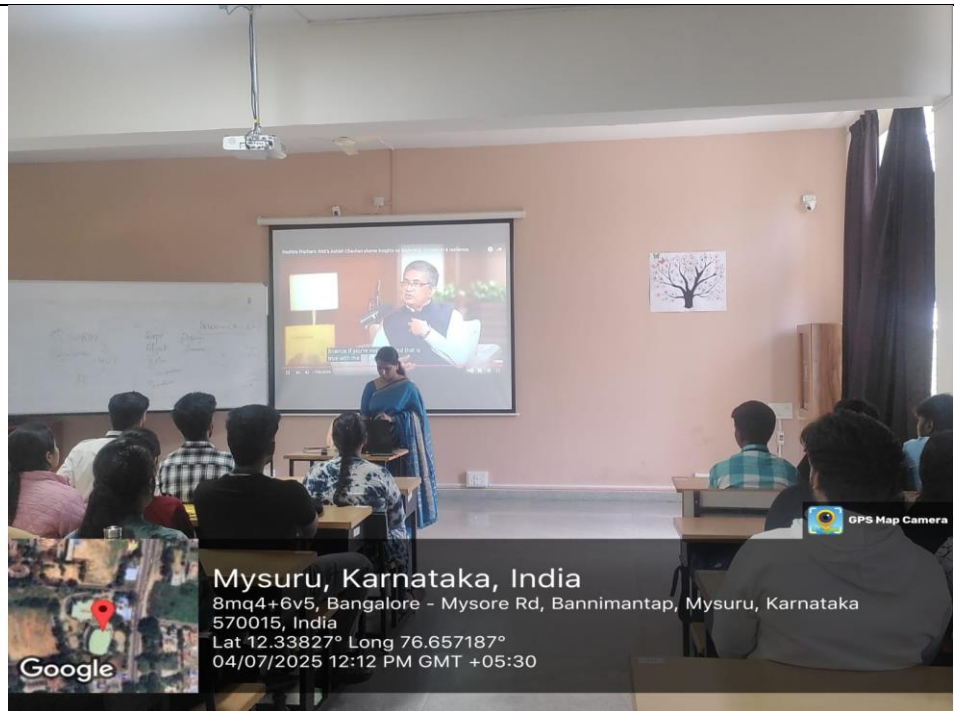
Key Insights / Takeaways
