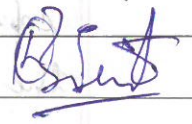
Agenda 4: Any other subject with the permission of the chair

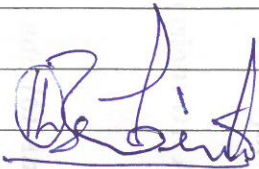

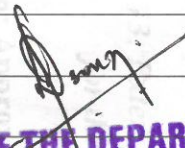
