Part B will contain eight questions with two subdivisions. The students will have to answer six questions of two marks each.

As far as the electives are concerned, the Vth Sem will have two electives consists of Discrete maths and mechanics and the IVth sem will have Topology as one of the electives.

The following changes and corrections in the syllabus was suggested.

- 1) In II semester, the maxima and minima for polynomials under partial differentiation was retained by introducing the basic polynomials.
- 2) In I semester unit - II, Solving the quadratic equation by Decarte's method was removed as they were many methods.
- 3) In II sem; Unit - I & II only statements were kept for theorems [Roll's Taylor's and Maclaurin's series for function of two variables]
- 4) In I sem; Unit 3:- Curvature of plane curve (parametric) form was removed.
In I sem; Unit 4:- Leibnitz Theorem (statement) only was be suggested.
- 5) In II sem:- Statement was kept for Euler's Phi-function, Wilson's, Euleri & Fermati thm. Taylor's theorem, Maclaurin Series.
- 6) In III sem: Differential Equation few methods were suggested.
- 7) For IV sem:- Suggestion was made to add infinite series [odd exponential, logarithmic series] and summation of series.
- 8) For question paper pattern, questions can be splitted into 2+3 or retain 5 marks. just to introduced 2 mks & 3 mks question if needed.
- 9) Practical Examination marks was cleared - it is 25 mks. In Exam (20+5) [5 for viva] 25 mks for Assignment (10). Test (10) & Record (5).
- 10) Publication year was need to be mentioned in References.

After all these suggestions and corrections the meeting was concluded by thanking the members.

Proceedings

1. Modification of Ist and IInd semester SEP syllabus.

The members discussed the new SEP syllabus of Ist and IInd semester and made the following

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changes:

- i) Previously there were four units which is now reduced to three units.
- ii) The Polar-coordinates topic from 3rd unit is shifted to 1st unit in new SEP syllabus.

2. Modification of IIIrd and IVth semester syllabus:

The board discussed IIIrd and IVth semester syllabus and made the following changes

- i) In IIIrd semester, Ordinary linear differential equations with constant co-efficients is shifted from Ist unit to IIIrd unit.
- ii) In IIIrd semester DSE paper - Numerical Analysis II: Successive over relaxation method is removed. Newton's divided differences and Newton's general interpolation formula topic is removed.
- iii) In IIIrd semester DSE paper - Advanced Calculus: Stoke's theorem is added in unit 3.
- iv) In IVth semester DSG paper - Algebra III and Calculus III: Euler's ϕ function, Wilson's theorem, Euler's theorem and Fermat's little theorem is added in unit 1.
- v) Introduction to group theory is shifted to unit 2.

3. Modification of blueprint of I, II, III and IV semester:

Mrs. Shruithi Meneses, chairman proposed the change in the blueprint of theory assessment. It was accepted by the board.

4. Any other matters:

Mrs. Shruithi Meneses, requested the board to give inputs regarding the SEC paper - Basics of LaTeX type setting. Prof. Veena Mathad emphasized the importance of overleaf and enlightened about the recent advancement in LaTeX.
